

Installing 0.8.5 Skyfire on a Symbian Device via SMS

The latest version of the Skyfire browser for Symbian devices requires Symbian (Nokia N or E series – third edition).

Note: Before beginning to install Skyfire, we recommend that you first stop all processes currently running on your device. To do this, press and hold the Menu key. A list of all currently running processes is displayed. Select each process and press the Clear key.

To install Skyfire on a Symbian Mobile device:

1. Go to <http://get.skyfire.com>.

The Skyfire delivery site is displayed.

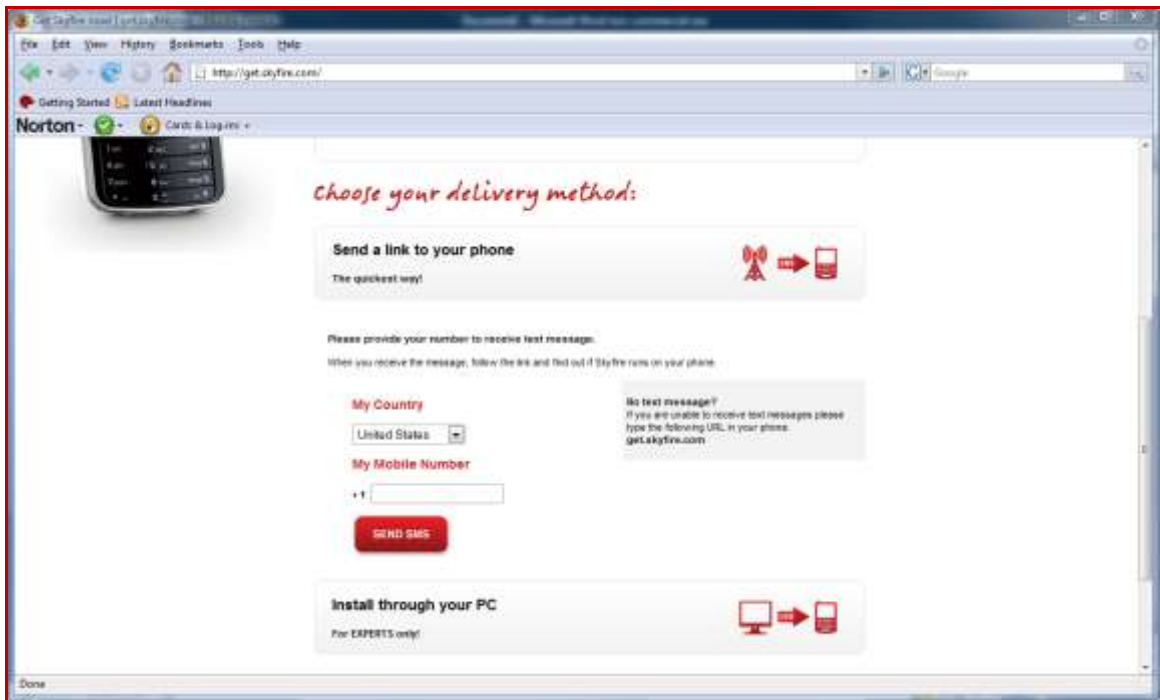


Figure 1 Skyfire Staging Site

You can choose from two options for installing Skyfire. The easiest option is to have an SMS sent from this site to your mobile device (see Installing Skyfire on Symbian via SMS). The second option is to install Skyfire through your PC (see Installing Skyfire on Symbian through your PC).

To install Skyfire from an SMS message:

1. Select the Send a link to your phone option on the Skyfire delivery site.
2. Select your country from the My Country drop-down menu.
3. Type your mobile phone number in the My Mobile Number field.

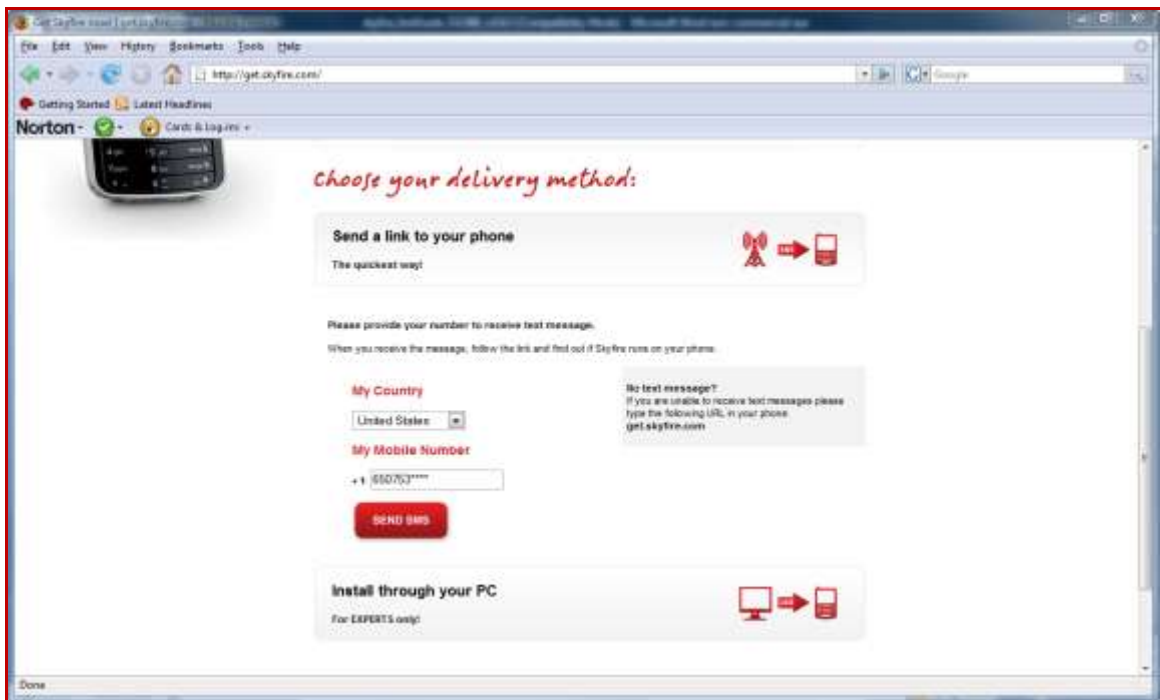


Figure 2 Send a link to your phone

4. Click Send SMS.

A SMS is sent to your phone. If you do not receive a SMS, you can install Skyfire by typing <http://get.skyfire.com> on your mobile internet browser.

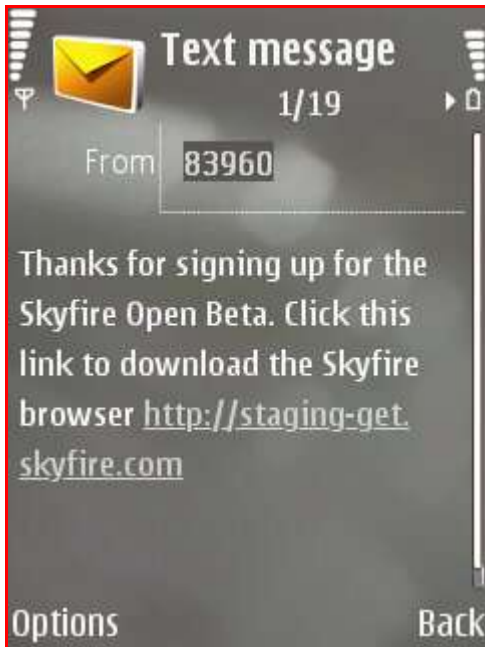


Figure 3 SMS from Skyfire

5. Select the link provided in the SMS message.
6. Select Open link.

You are asked to select an access point.

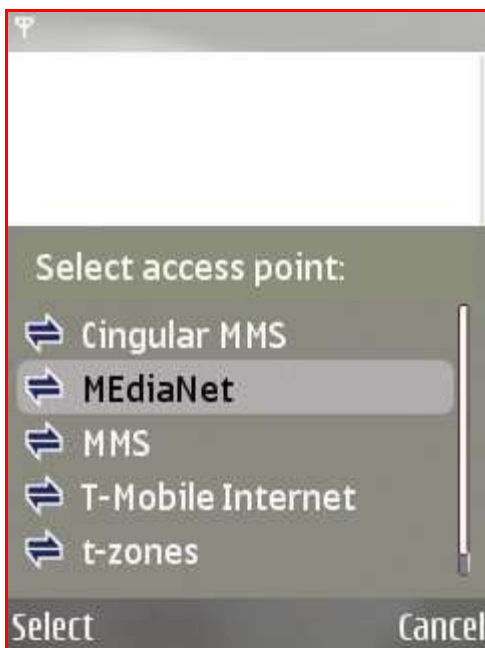


Figure 4 SMS from Skyfire

7. Select the appropriate carrier access point.

The Download Skyfire page is displayed.

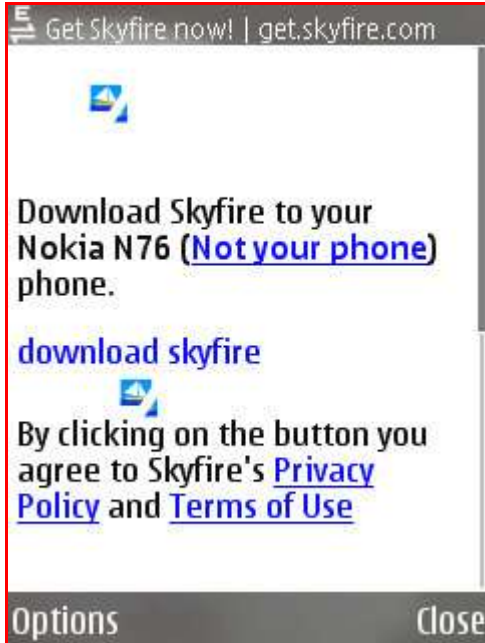


Figure 5 Download Skyfire

You are told which type of device you are installing on. In this example, Skyfire is being installed on a Nokia N76. If the device mentioned on the Download Skyfire screen is not your device, select Not your phone. You will be brought to a page on which you can select the correct device type.

8. Select Download Skyfire.

You are asked if you want to install Skyfire.

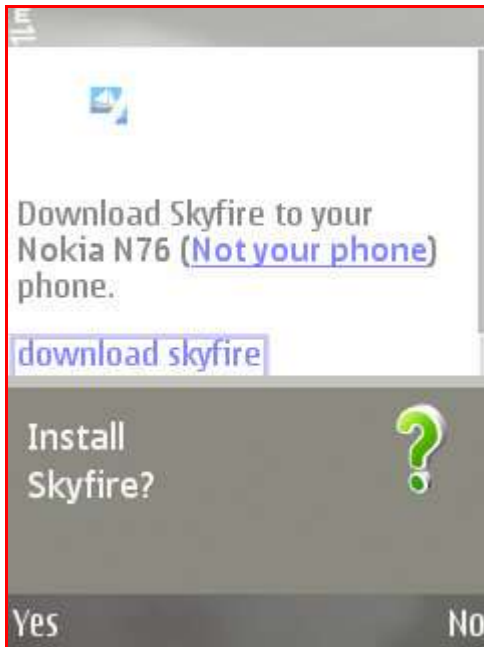


Figure 6 Install Skyfire?

9. Select Yes.

A security warning is displayed.

10. Select Continue.

The download details are displayed.

11. Select Continue.

You are asked to choose a location to install Skyfire. We strongly recommend that you select Phone Memory to install directly to the device.

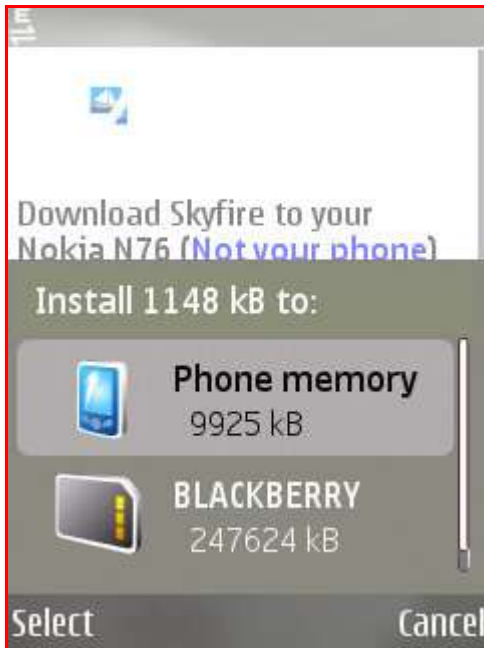


Figure 7 Choose Install Location

12. Highlight Phone Memory and press Select.

The Application Access screen is displayed.

13. Click Continue.

Details screens are displayed.

14. Click Continue on all Details screens.

The Skyfire license agreement page is displayed.

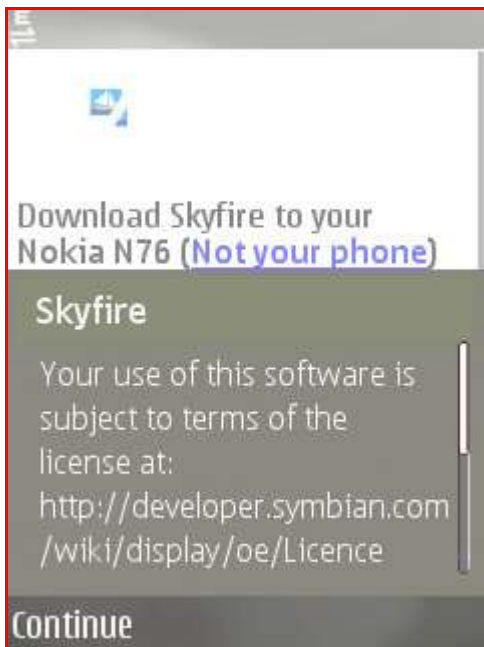


Figure 8 Beta Evaluation Agreement

15. Select Continue to indicate your acceptance of the license agreement.

Skyfire is installed to the Applications folder on your device.

16. To launch Skyfire, browse to the Applications folder on your device and select Skyfire.

You are asked to select an access point.

17. Select the carrier Internet option, for example, T-Mobile Internet.

After a short loading period, the Skyfire start page is displayed.
