

Installing 0.8.5 Skyfire on a Windows Mobile Device via SMS

The latest version of the Skyfire browser for touchscreen and non-touchscreen devices requires Windows Mobile 5 or 6.

The following steps describe how to install Skyfire on a touchscreen device. The same steps apply for installing Skyfire on a non-touchscreen device.

Note: Before beginning to install Skyfire, we recommend that you first stop all processes currently running on your device. To do this, select Start | Settings and click on the System tab. Then select Memory, select the Running Programs tab and select Stop All.

To install Skyfire on a Windows Mobile device:

1. Go to <http://get.skyfire.com>.

The Skyfire delivery site is displayed.

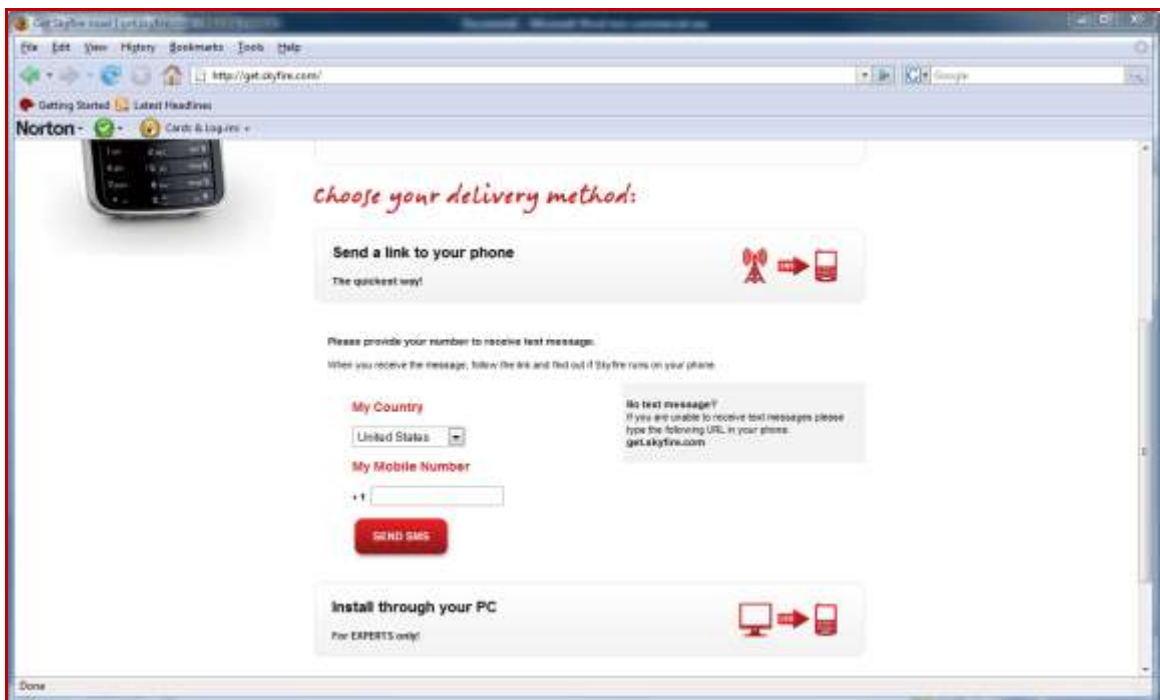


Figure 1 Skyfire Staging Site

You can choose from two options for installing Skyfire. The easiest option is to have an SMS sent from this site to your mobile device (see Installing

Skyfire on Windows Mobile via SMS). The second option is to install Skyfire through your PC (see Installing Skyfire on Windows Mobile through your PC).

Note If your phone cannot receive text messages, you can install Skyfire directly by going to <http://get.skyfire.com> on your phone's mobile browser.

To install Skyfire via SMS message from the Skyfire delivery site:

1. Select the Send a link to your phone option on the Skyfire delivery site.
2. Select your country from the My Country drop-down menu.
3. Type your mobile phone number in the My Mobile Number field.

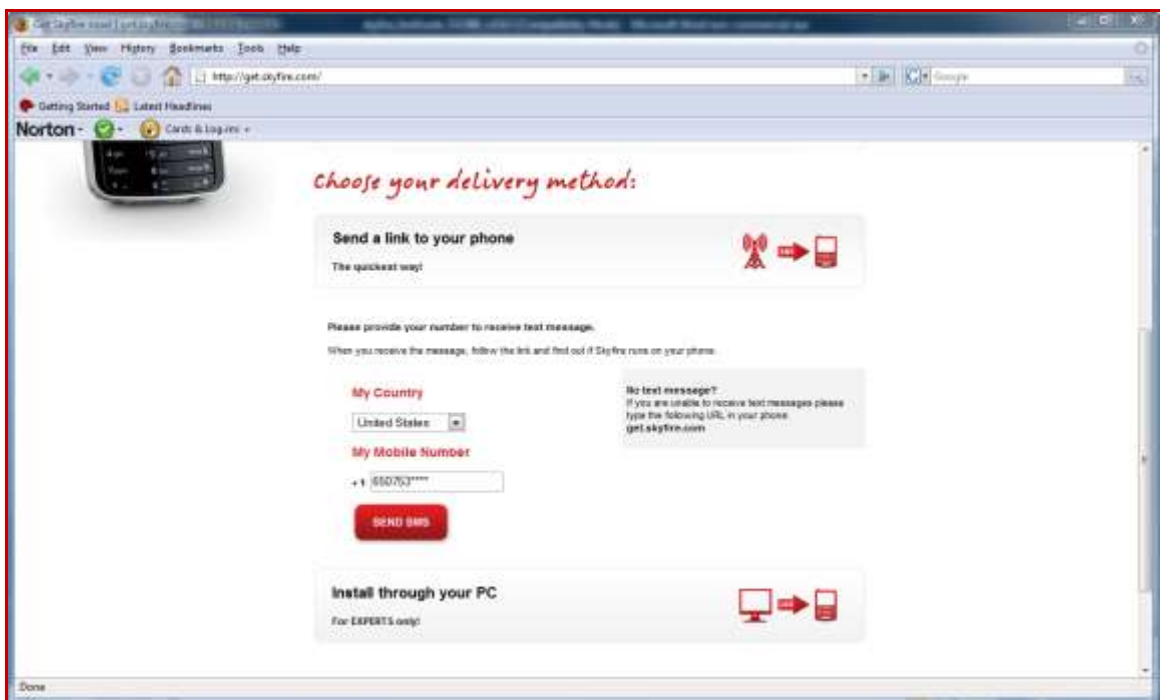


Figure 2 Send a link to your phone

4. Click Send SMS.

A SMS is sent to your phone. If you do not receive a SMS, you can install Skyfire by typing <http://get.skyfire.com> on your mobile internet browser.

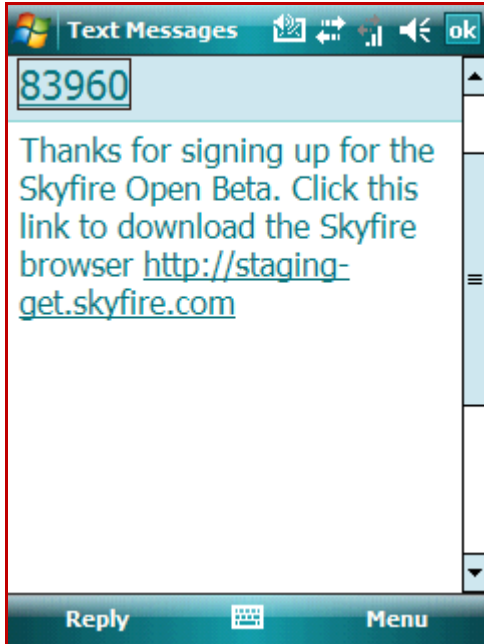


Figure 3 SMS from Skyfire

5. Click on the link provided in the SMS message.

The Download Skyfire page is displayed.

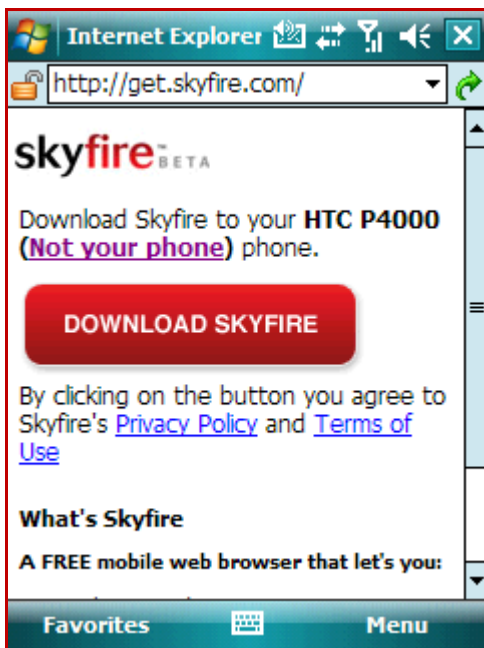


Figure 4 Download Skyfire

You are told which type of device you are installing on. In this example, Skyfire is being installed on a HTC P4000. If the device mentioned on the Download Skyfire screen is not your device, select Not your phone. You will be brought to a page on which you can select the correct device type.

6. Select Download Skyfire.

You are asked if you would like to download the Skyfire CAB file.

7. Select Yes.

A warning may be displayed asking if you trust the publisher of this file.

8. Select Yes to continue.

The next screen allows you to install the Skyfire Home Screen Search bar. This allows you to add a Skyfire search and URL bar to your Windows Mobile Today screen. With this Super Bar you can enter what you are looking for right away without first starting Skyfire. Leave this option selected to see this feature in action.

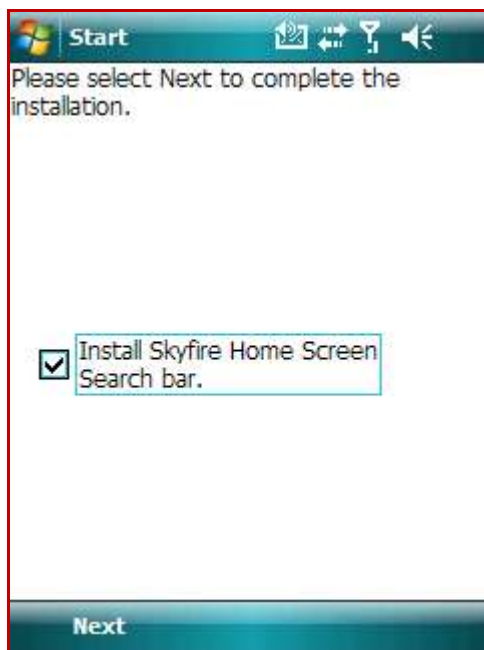


Figure 5 Install Skyfire Home Screen Search

9. Select Next.

Skyfire is now installed.

10. Select Launch.

The Skyfire beta evaluation agreement page is displayed.

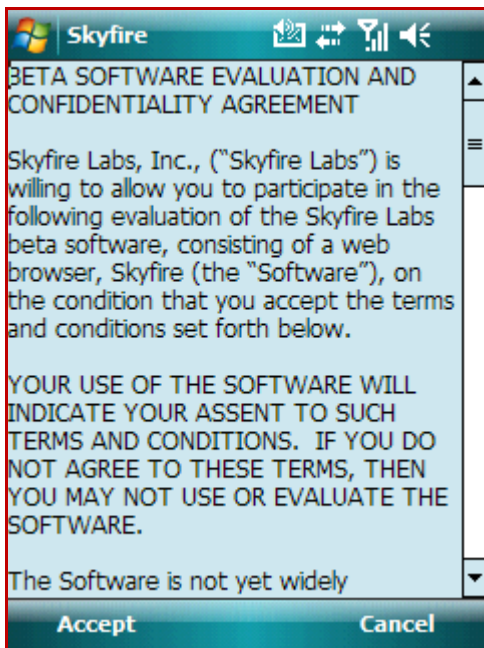


Figure 6 Beta Evaluation Agreement

11. Select Accept to indicate your acceptance of the license agreement.

A data usage charges warning is displayed. This warning is displayed only during initial setup – it will not appear when you next launch Skyfire.

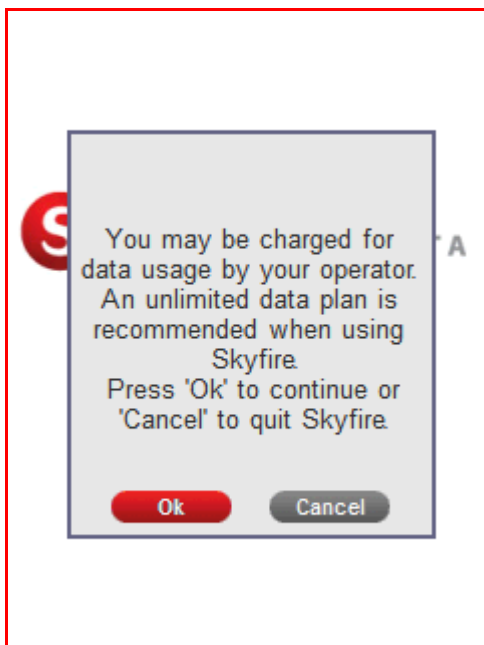


Figure 7 Usage Charges Warning

12. Select OK.

After a short loading period, the Skyfire start page is displayed.
